Prophecies

All through the Bible there are prophecies about things to come, promises God makes to His people. The prophets in the Old Testament announced the Lord's birth into this world hundreds of years before it actually happened: *"For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder."* Isaiah 55:6

While He was in the world, Jesus told His followers many things about the future - He predicted His own death, but He also assured them that He would still be present with them. *"A little while, and you will not see Me; and again a little while, and you will see Me, because I go to the Father."* John 16:16

Sometimes it sounded like another person - "Spirit of Truth" - would come into the world: *"When He, the Spirit of Truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth."* John 16:13

And in John 16:25 Jesus said, *"These things I have spoken to you in figurative language; but the time is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figurative language, but will tell you plainly about the Father."*

The Book of Revelation is symbolic.

"I saw the Holy City, the New Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God." Revelation 21:2

The book of Revelation talks about the coming of the "Holy City New Jerusalem." This is not predicting that an actual city will come down from the sky. It is very beautiful promise, described symbolically, about a new understanding of Christianity, a new understanding of the Bible.

In the middle of the city New Jerusalem stood the tree of life:

"And the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations." Revelation 22:2

The "leaves" of the tree stand for all of the teachings of the New Church. These new teachings make sense of some of the confusing and seemingly contradictory messages in the Bible. They bring a clear understanding of God and the purpose of creation. They can spiritually heal us, our families, our countries, and our planet.



Some of these teachings are:

God is Love - nothing but what is good can come from God, because His very nature is Love. God came to this world in the form of Jesus Christ, who is the one and only God.

The Word - the Bible has a deeper meaning taught in the New Church, so people can know the Lord and better learn how to live happy and useful lives to eternity.

All religions have goodness in them - there are many paths to heaven.

Heaven is for everyone who wants to live there - heaven is where people (angels) love God and others, and want to be useful. While people are free to choose to live forever in hell, God wants everyone to live with Him to eternity.
